**Spc. Nicholas K. Rogers, 27, of Deltona, Fla.**, died Oct. 22 in Baghdad, Iraq, from injuries suffered when his patrol came in contact with enemy forces during combat operations. Rogers was assigned to the 4th Battalion, 31st Infantry Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 10th Mountain Division, Fort Drum, N.Y.

**Lance Cpl. Richard A. Buerstetta, 20, of Franklin, Tenn.** Buerstetta died Oct. 23 while conducting combat operations in Al Anbar province, Iraq. He was assigned to Marine Forces Reserve's 3rd Battalion, 24th Marine Regiment, 4th Marine Division, Nashville, Tenn.

**Lance Cpl. Tyler R. Overstreet, 22, of Gallatin, Tenn.** Overstreet died Oct. 23 while conducting combat operations in Al Anbar province, Iraq. He was assigned to Marine Forces Reserve's 3rd Battalion, 24th Marine Regiment, 4th Marine Division, Nashville, Tenn.

**Spc. Carl A. Eason, 29, of Lovelady, Texas**, died Oct. 23 in Baghdad, Iraq, from injuries suffered when an improvised explosive device detonated near his vehicle.
